

### Why We Build E-Ecosystems

- In 2006, rural mayors began to recognize that "smoke stack chasing" was too competitive, looking for alternative
- Rural entrepreneurs have no support system

Thriving new businesses are strongest catalyst for **hope** in a persistently poor community



### **Building E-Communities**

- January 2014: Launched strategic partnership with Center for Rural Entrepreneurship
- Purpose: Translate CRE framework and tools for leaders in persistently poor rural places
- February 2014: Dumas, AR
  - Population: 4538
  - Living in Poverty: 38%
  - Demographics: 62.8% African American
     5.4% Hispanic , 30.8% Caucasian
  - Unemployment: 14.2%
  - Leakage \$14.8 million in retail sales
- August 2015: Newport, AR
  - Population: 7879
  - Living in Poverty: 35.6%
  - Demographics: 25.3% African American
    - 3.9% Hispanic, 67.3% Caucasian
  - Unemployment: 10.5%
